Interim Director and Professor of Innovation Policy, School for the Future of Innovation in Society, USA, Arizona State University

Eusebio Scornavacca is interim director and professor at the School for the Future of Innovation in Society, College of Global Futures, at Arizona State University (ASU). He is also Professor of Digital Innovation at and Thunderbird School of Global Management and Senior Global Futures Scientist at ASU's Julie Ann Wrigley Global Futures Laboratory. Prior to joining ASU, Prof. Scornavacca was the Parsons Professor of Digital Innovation and Director of the Center for Digital Communication, Commerce and Culture at the University of Baltimore. Eusebio is a global scholar with a strong research collaboration network across six continents. He has held visiting positions in Japan, China, Egypt, Italy, France, Finland, Spain, New Zealand, Morocco, and Brazil. His research interests include disruptive digital innovation, high-impact innovation, innovation policy, digital entrepreneurship, ICT for development, and digital ecosystems. During the past 25 years, he has conducted multidisciplinary research using qualitative and quantitative methods in a wide range of industries, including research sponsored by the private sector. He has also rather extensive developing multinational, cross-disciplinary inquiry-based projects. Prof. Scornavacca's research has appeared in leading journals and conferences. He has also held several editorial positions and served as a track chair at leading conferences.
